Garganega Torre del Falasco 2015 (Italy)

The Garganega grape is the main grape behind Soave - this is luscious with hints of apricots and peach - full and rich on the finish.

Le Tuffeau Sauvignon Blanc 2014 (France)

Le Tuffeau is a super-fresh, zippy Sauvignon with vibrant, ripe citrus-fruit aromas. The grapes are sourced from vineyards near the beautiful town of Carcassonne in Southern France. A versatile wine that will match most of the fish dishes.

Spanish White 2015 (Castilla y León, Spain)

After a number of seafood delights while filming in Galicia and drinking cold Castilla y León from white china cups, I had to find a really well made one for us. It's charmingly fresh and fragrant. Made with Virura and Verdejo grapes, it's a wine to celebrate my Spanish book and TV series.

Pinot Grigio Villa Fiore 2015 (Venezia Giulia, Italy)

Many Pinot Grigios that you come across these days are weak and dull with none of the smell and flavour of the grape. This shows exactly how Pinot Grigio should taste, soft but crisp acidity and a faintly spicy element which marks the fruit of this wine.

Muscadet Sevre et Maine sur lie domaine Gadais Pere et Fils 2015 (Loire, France)

Really first class Muscadet, perfect with oysters... you don't believe it? Drinking is believing!

Cazas Novas Vinho Verde 2014 (Portugal)

Vinho Verde's are getting better and better - made using the local grape variety Avesso, very fresh apple and citrus aromas - delicate clean and crisp.

Snapper Rock Sauvignon Blanc 2016 (Marlborough, New Zealand)

I find many New Zealand Sauvignons to be almost oppressively fruit laden. The Snapper Rock though is much more subtle and at a recent tasting we liked it best because of its good balance of leafy flavour with a pleasing round finish.

Chablis Jean-Marc Brocard 2015 (Burgundy, France)

This is one of the liveliest, freshest wines I've tasted for a long time.

40th Anniversary White Burgundy 2014 Julien Collovray (France)

We are very proud of this wine, the family went down in 2013 to choose the cuvée and each year after the wine has been outstanding.

Rich and smooth and concentrated with mulberries, cassis and red cherries, with soft and silky tannins.

Rick Stein Spanish Red Garnacha 2015 (Spain)

Rick and his son Charlie worked together to select this wine to match with the flavours he encountered on his journey through Spain. A delicious, juicy and ripe Spanish red made from Garnacha

Colonia las Liebres Bonarda 2014 (Mendoza, Argentina)

From the high altitude vineyards of Mendoza comes a new rising star "Bonarda" - it's home is Italy but the success is here in Mendoza - lots of dark fruits with layers of chocolate and mint - really ripe and juicy.
