WHITE WINE

ASSYRTIKO, SANTO WINES, SANTORINI, GREECE 2017

Crisp and clean thanks to its volcanic minerality, there is a lovely rounded and silky mouthfeel from the warmer climate here in the southern corner of the Med.

Dry Vouvray like this or Savennières are good with dishes like Turbot and Hollandaise sauce.

ALVARINHO, ADEGA DE MONCAO, VINHO VERDE, PORTUGAL 2017

Vinho Verdes are getting better and better – made using the local grape variety Alvarinho which goes brilliantly with shellfish. Very fresh apple and citrus aromas, delicate clean and crisp. – *Charlie*
