### WHITE

#### SOAVE, PIEROPAN, CLASSICO SUPERIORE, ITALY 2015

Suppose you wanted to know why many Italian whites go so well with fish but in a different way to how French whites work, I'd suggest the Pieropan Soave would be it. I embarrass myself by usually ordering it if I see it on the wine list.

I first heard about Xanadu in Margaret River when one of our chefs went over to run their restaurant and was raving about the wines. This is their Exmoor Drive Chardonnay which is fresh and creamy with not too much oak.
