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RICK'S SPECIAL SELECTION

MUSCADET SÈVRE-ET-MAINE SUR LA GRANDE RESERVE, GADAIS, FRANCE 2020

It's great to have a proper Muscadet on the list again. This is a Sur Lie, it reminds me of the early days of The Seafood Restaurant and trips to Brittany and plates of Fruits de Mer.

CHATEAU BAUDUC SEMILLON LES TROIS HECTARES VIEILLES VIGNES, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2021

An old vine Sémillon of real distinction, soft and rounded with a beautifully supple, dry texture. This is more subtle and elegant in its flavour-profiles, and lower in acidity, than the petit château's signature Sauvignon Blanc, with wonderful complexity and length.

GARGANEGA SAUVIGNON BLANC CHARDONNAY, ANSELMI SAN VICENZO IGT, VENETO, ITALY 2021

Fruity, youthful style, reminiscent of hazelnuts and peaches. No wood maturation just clean crisp flavours with a long finish.

SANCERRE LA MERCY-DIEU, DOMAINE BAILLY-REVERDY, LOIRE, FRANCE 2021

I must say this is a serious wine, it's slightly austere and extremely elegant from a famed producer.

WHITE

AZAL ABC DARIUM, VINHO VERDE DOC, PORTUGAL 2021

Vinho Verdes are getting better and better, this goes so well with shellfish. Very fresh apple and citrus aromas, delicate clean and crisp.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, SAVAGE, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA 2022

SA's very own Mr Sauvignon Blanc, Duncan Savage, has crafted here a wonderful, scintillating modern Savvy using grapes from a wind-blown 32 year old vineyard in Stellenbosch. Cape gooseberry, quince and peach tea scents with a tight, nervy, salty finale.

RIESLING, STEFAN WINTER, RHEINHESSEN, GERMANY 2021

Spontaneous fermentation gives an exciting tension expressing flavours reminiscent of ripe apricots, peaches, orange zest and tropical fruit on the nose. The palate shows complexity, a crisp character and excellent length with long lingering fruit.

ALIGOTÉ, DOMAINE DU PRIEURE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2020

White, Burgundy made from the Aligoté grape is increasingly rare, especially in the area of Savigny where Pinot Noir and Chardonnay dominate. It is a fresh and easy drinking wine with good balance and lively acidity, which makes it a fine accompaniment to seafood or on its own as an aperitif.

Suppose you wanted to know why many Italian whites go so well with fish but in a different way to how French whites work, I'd suggest the Pieropan Soave would be it. - Rick

RED

PINOT NOIR, SOLI, THRACIAN VALLEY, BULGARIA 2019

Bulgaria might not be the first place that comes to mind when thinking of quality Pinot Noir, however in a sheltered little vineyard on the eastern side of the Thracian Valley, Italian winemaker Edoardo Miroglio is crafting delicious, juicy, perfumed pinot. I've tried this blind against many different pinot noirs from around the world and I was convinced it was a Santenay from Burgundy - and I wasn't the only one in the group. The wine is light, fresh, fragrant with redcurrant and wild strawberry fruit and it's dangerously easy to drink.

"STEIN'S" BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR ROUGE, FRANCE 2018

Stein's Bordeaux is our own blend of Merlot and Cabernet created with the help of our friends in the south of Bordeaux. It's a soft and juicy claret that is exactly the right wine to go with a steak frites or a plate of cheese.

SPARKLING WINE

VEUVE CLICQUOT PONSARDIN, VINTAGE BRUT, CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE 2012

"On the palate, the attack is fresh and frank. Then appear the first aromas of fruits with mirabelle tart, candied citrus and roasted pears notes. Finally, refreshing notes of green hazelnuts and almonds arise."

WHITE

MALVASIA, 'ANCESTRALE', CANTINA ORSOGNA, ABRUZZO, ITALY 2021 (ORANGE WINE)

From the consistently impressive Cantina Orsogna in Abruzzo this is an outstanding example of a white wine made in the way red wines are made (loads of skin contact) which makes for the orange colour (and name). It is fresh and full of mango and pineapple flavours balanced impeccably with acidity and a texture which makes for an very pleasant introduction to the orange wine style.

Full, balanced and very aromatic. Depending on the vintage, the principal aromas of Gewurztraminer are lychee, rose, ginger and geranium. The Trimbach Gewurztraminer is dry and shows classic restraint, without any loss of the Gewurztraminer's exotic and spicy feature.

PROSECCO SPUMANTE, ERA ORGANIC, DOC TREVISO ITALY

GROS MANSENG SAUVIGNON BLANC, DOMAINE HORGELUS, CÔTES DE GASGOGNE, FRANCE 2021

Situated on the sunny hillsides of Gascony, this region, renowned for centuries thanks to its Armagnac, now reveals itself as a promising French Appellation due to the increasing quality of its local wines. The duo of Sauvignon and Gros-Manseng will seduce you with its intense notes of exotic and citrus fruits, with a streak of minerality and freshness.

MUSCADET SÈVRE-ET-MAINE SUR LA GRANDE RESERVE, GADAI, FRANCE 2020

I'm writing this from my desk in Padstow with a view across the Camel estuary the tide is in, and on the other side I can see the Porthilly oyster baskets in the distance and I'm salivating at the thought of my favourite food and wine match, Muscadet and Oysters. Muscadet is an electric shock of a wine, buzzing with fresh acidity and refreshing saline citrus fruit, when teamed with those gorgeous briny, salty, metallic fruits of the sea then you get the perfect combo.

PICPOUL DE PINET, RÉSERVE DE LA ROQUEMOLIÈRE, FRANCE 2021

You couldn't want for a more perfect shellfish wine if you tried, Picpoul is the grape and it has bags of natural acidity, and is light, crisp, clean; the perfect attributes to match with briny oysters or luxurious langoustines. The locals call it 'lip stinger' because of its zingy acidity and they wallop it down with the local Mediterranean oysters that grown right next to the vines.

AZAL ABC DARIUM, VINHO VERDE DOC, PORTUGAL 2021

ROSE WINE

CHATEAU BAUDUC ROSE, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2021

This dry rosé was made from equal parts of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.

The grapes were harvested earlier in September than for making red, and the pale juice quickly run off the dark skins for a light, crisp wine.

CÔTES DE PROVENCE, LOVE, CHATEAU LEOUBE (ORGANIC), PROVENCE, FRANCE 2021

Provence rose is a tremendous success story, for me it always makes me think of a blazing hot day by the piscine in the south of France, even if I'm sitting in my flat on a wet Friday evening. Leoube are 100% organic, and make fantastic rosé with elegance and poise, lots of crunchy red fruit and they make it very easy to slip down.

CÔTES DE PROVENCE, WHISPERING ANGEL ROSÉ, PROVENCE, FRANCE 2021

To do so, he introduced ground-breaking winemaking techniques, this revolutionised Provence rosé - with Whispering Angel as the figurehead. It has fresh notes of apple, pink grapefruit, peach, cream and a long smooth finish.

SANGIOVESE, ERA ORGANIC, CANTINE VOLPI, MARCHE, ITALY 2020

Deep plummy fruit with hints of liquorice and spice, warm and well rounded. Nice firm tannins and a good amount of body make this a great food wine, from the Marche region. This popular red is also conveniently available in winebox format.

It wants to give you simple, uncomplicated pleasure, that's every bit as delicious as the wine itself. And there's nothing wrong - in fact, there's everything right - with that.
