RICK'S SPECIAL SELECTION WHITE WINES

MUSCADET SÈVRE-ET-MAINE SUR LIE COTES GRANDLIEU, DOMAINE HERBAUGES, FRANCE 2019

It's great to have a proper Muscadet on the list again. This is a Sur Lie, it reminds me of the early days of The Seafood Restaurant and trips to Brittany and plates of Fruits de Mer.

SOAVE CLASSICO, PIEROPAN, VENETO, ITALY 2019

Suppose you wanted to know why many Italian whites go so well with fish but in a different way to how French whites work, I'd suggest the Pieropan Soave would be the one.

CHARLIE'S SPECIAL SELECTION WHITE WINES

LOUREIRO, AB VALLEY WINES, VINHO VERDE, PORTUGAL 2019

Vinho Verdes are getting better and better, this goes so well with shellfish. Very fresh apple and citrus aromas, delicate clean and crisp.

CUSTOZA, GORGIO DI ROBERTA, VENETO, ITALY 2019

This elegant white from the Bianco di Custoza region of Veneto is a pale lemon colour with a fresh nose of apple and honeysuckle. The palate is soft and round with pink lady apples, lemon peel and peaches, fresh acidity and a pronounced mineral note gives good balance and structure to the wine.

ALIGOTÉ, DOMAINE DU PRIEURE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2019

White, Burgundy made from the Aligoté grape is increasingly rare, especially in the area of Savigny where Pinot Noir and Chardonnay dominate. It is a fresh, easy drinking wine with good balance and lively acidity, which makes it a fine accompaniment to seafood or on its own as an aperitif.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, SAVAGE, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA 2020

SA's very own Mr Sauvignon Blanc, Duncan Savage, has crafted here a wonderful, scintillating modern Savvy using grapes from a wind-blown 32 year old vineyard in Stellenbosch. Cape gooseberry, quince and peach tea scents with a tight, nervy, salty finale.

RIESLING, STEFAN WINTER, RHEINHESSEN, GERMANY 2019

Spontaneous fermentation gives an exciting tension expressing flavours reminiscent of ripe apricots, peaches, orange zest and tropical fruit on the nose. The palate shows complexity, a crisp character and excellent length with long lingering fruit.

WHITE WINE

CHARDONNAY PLANETA ESTATE, SICILY, ITALY 2018

Golden yellow with greenish hue. On the nose this wonderful wine comes layered and delicious, with citrus fruit flavours, chestnut, honey and a spicy complexity. As good as top Cru white, Burgundy, at half the price.

BOURGOGNE BLANC, DOMAINE LEFLAIVE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

A taut nose of green apple, apricot and rich white pear fruit, with flashes of lemon zest. The palate is gratifyingly plump, quite plush, with grapefruit and pithy white peach. Brisk acidity and stony-mineral definition make for a reassuring counterpoint on the finish. "This will hit the ground running – as is the intention! Excellent classical Bourgogne Blanc."

PULIGNY-MONTRACHET, DAVID MORET, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2018

This Chardonnay has pale golden hues in the glass, with zesty citrus aromas. It is generous on the palate with spicy undertones and a lingering finish. Delicious and complex, it is difficult to find a white wine quite like it outside of Burgundy.

SAINT-ÉMILION, XX DE CORBIN, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2014

XX de Corbin, Saint Emilion, France, it is the second wine of Chateau Corbin. Anabelle Cruse Bardinet is the wine maker and produces a medium bodied, soft wine with a forward nose of fresh blackberry jam and red berry fruits.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE

PROSECCO SPUMANTE, ERA ORGANIC, DOC TREVISO ITALY

A dry style of Prosecco but with well-balanced fruit and with well-balanced aromas. Grown organically on the hills of Treviso in the Veneto region.

ENGLISH OAK, ENGELMANN BRUT, DORSET, ENGLAND 2017

Light gold in colour , intensely floral, vivacious brown sugar and fresh citrus notes demand attention on the nose, dancing into vibrant and zingy, gooseberry, pink grapefruit and a hint of crème brûlée on the palate "with an intriguing touch of herbs" on the finish.

NYETIMBER CLASSIC CUVEE, WEST CHILTON, ENGLAND

A blend of wines made in two consecutive vintages, the wine is bottle aged for three years prior to release. The aromas are reminiscent of apple orchards and elderflowers.

Seemingly very dry, the dosage is 10 g/l of sugar; the palate shows lemon, mineral notes and a soft mousse.

VERMENTINO VIEILLES VIGNES, LES ARCHERES, PAYS D'OC, FRANCE 2019

Bright yellow with green hues. Floral, peachy and white blossom aromas are met with a soft, creamy and well-balanced palate.

GARNACHA CHARDONNAY, CARE BLANCO, SOBRE LIAS ROSCA, CARIÑENA, SPAIN 2019

In the world of wine at the moment, Spain is making some of the most interesting and best value bottles in the world. Its wine-growing areas and yields are so varied it's never been a better or easier time to venture off the beaten track away from the stalwarts of Cava and Rioja into a delicious sensual world of texture and freshness. This grenache blanc chardonnay from near Zaragoza is a total knockout: it's super fresh, but it's also spent some time in contact with older "dead" yeast cells after fermentation which gives the wine a rounded feel in the mouth.

SAUVIGNON BLANC GROS MANSENG, DOMAINE HORGELUS, CÔTES DE GASGOGNE, FRANCE 2020

Situated on the sunny hillsides of Gascony, this region, renowned for centuries thanks to its Armagnac, now reveals itself as a promising French Appellation due to the increasing quality of its local wines. The duo of Sauvignon and Gros-Manseng will seduce you with its intense notes of exotic and citrus fruits, with a streak of minerality and freshness.

PECORINO, TIERRE CHIETI TOR COLLE, ITALY 2019

A crisp and fresh Pecorino from Abruzzo; lemon-green in colour with blossom and grapefruit aromas on the nose. The palate is dry and crisp with a zesty citrus acidity and notes of white peach, pear and green apples.

FIANO, LUNATE, SICILY, ITALY 2019

Fiano can produce wonderfully complex white wines. Lunate have produced a fine example of what can be achieved with this underrated grape variety. Aromatic nose offering floral notes and hints of honey and spice.

The palate has good weight and plenty of fruit, whilst there is enough acidity to keep the finish fresh and clean. Serious wine for the price

XAREL-LO/MACABEU, BLAU CEL, TARRAGONA, CATALONIA, SPAIN 2019

Grapes for Blau Cel are hand harvested and vinified using the fewest possible additives and a very low sulfite content. The different grape varieties are vinified separately. The wine is florally aromatic with soft white fruit flavours and a refreshing acidity wholly redolent of its Mediterranean origin.

After several seafood delights whilst filming in Galicia and drinking a number of

Ruedas from white china cups, I had to find a really good one for us. I asked Charlie to find something made from the Verdejo grape, it's a wine to celebrate my Spanish book and TV series.

These wines are drinking perfectly now, and also are selected to go well with the food you are cooking at home, or also one of our 'Stein's at Home' boxes. - Charlie

PICPOUL DE PINET, RÉSERVE DE LA ROQUEMOLIÈRE, FRANCE 2019

You couldn't want for a more perfect shellfish wine if you tried, Picpoul is the grape and it has bags of natural acidity, and is light, crisp, clean; the perfect attributes to match with briny oysters or luxurious langoustines. The locals call it 'lip stinger' because of its zingy acidity and they wallop it down with the local Mediterranean oysters that grown right next to the vines.

MUSCADET SÈVRE-ET-MAINE SUR LIE COTES GRANDLIEU, DOMAINE HERBAUGES, FRANCE 2019

I'm writing this from my desk in Padstow with a view across the Camel estuary the tide is in, and on the other side I can see the Porthilly oyster baskets in the distance and I'm salivating at the thought of my favourite food and wine match, Muscadet and Oysters. Muscadet is an electric shock of a wine, buzzing with fresh acidity and refreshing saline citrus fruit, when teamed with those gorgeous briny, salty, metallic fruits of the sea then you get the perfect combo.

CHARDONNAY, DE MARTINO LEGADO, LIMARI VALLEY, CHILE 2018

This wine comes from Limarí Valley. The geography of this valley, which is wide open and with access to the sea, means that there are excellent climatic conditions for the production of this variety. The nose is intense, with notes of almonds and citric fruits. The palate is full-bodied, with great volume, very good acidity and a salty finish.

CUSTOZA, GORGIO DI ROBERTA, VENETO, ITALY 2019

Legend aside, Sicily has a rich history of winemaking, with evidence of vines being planted by the Greeks as far back as the 8th century BC. The whole island makes incredible wines. The island has so many interesting native grape varieties just waiting to be explored and tasted, one of my favourites is Grillo, and this one from the famous producer on Island, Planeta is a belter, luscious, waxy, and full of orange peel and peach fruit.

A 'natural wine', made without adding protective sulphur dioxide. This results in a golden yellow colour, aromas and flavours of bruised orchard fruits and a distinct tingly tang of acidity.

This Soave Classico is everything you would expect from this great producer. Subtle fruit, a pleasant nutty character and a long dry finish. Superb.

I love this wine! Vouvray is a wine-growing area in the Loire Valley, they make their wines from the Chenin Blanc grape. This is a dry example which is all about the acidity and freshness, with wildflower and quince fruit. It's full of energy, almost lazer like acidity, and is the perfect partner for shellfish. Delicious.

CHABLIS, DOMAINE GAUTHERON, BURGUNDY FRANCE 2018

The Gautheron estate has been family owned for five generations making very traditional Chablis from 25ha of vineyard. Their Chablis offers fresh, floral aromas, apple fruit and complex, rich mineral character derived from the subtle influence of the chalky vineyard soils. Fermentation and maturation is in vat to preserve the fresh steely flavours and lively balanced citrus finish.

I met winemaker Jessica Saurwein in her tiny vineyard wedged in between willows and commercial apple trees, we tried this delightful Riesling amongst the vines. Slightly off dry and perfect with our spicier dishes. - Charlie

CHARDONNAY, RED CLAW, MORNINGTON, AUSTRALIA 2017

An enticing Chardonnay with classic citrus and stonefruit aromas and a clean lifted mineral palate.

Produced from Yabby Lake's estate vineyards in Australia's renowned Mornington Peninsula, winemaker Tom Carson has produced this vibrant and elegant style with minimal handling and French oak barrels.

LINDI CARIEN WHITE BLEND, LOURENS FAMILY WINES, WALKER BAY, SOUTH AFRICA 2017

So fine and spicy with nice grip. Lemons, tangerines and orange peel. Lovely texture to this wine. Very fine with a lovely lemony, spicy edge.

SAVAGNIN OUILLÉ LA PIERRE, LES GRANGES PAQUENESSES, CÔTES DU JURA, FRANCE 2015/2016

La Pierre is the name of a small parcel in Pupillin, where Loreline's 25-year-old Savagnin vines are planted in light, sandy soil. This is a notably elegant style of topped up Savagnin which shows its supreme versatility as a food wine. Aged in 3–5-year-old barrels, it has zesty lime, confit lemons and a hint of menthol on the nose. Powerful and spicy on the palate with characteristic salinity and an attractive bitter grapefruit edge to the finish.

SAVAGE WHITE BLEND, WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA 2019

Beautifully complex and intense, the aromatics show notes of freshly cut fennel, yellow baking apples, waxy lemon peel and hints of fresh wet thatch. On the palate, it's just as impressive with nervy, pithy yellow grapefruit peel zest, white citrus spice, tangerine and peach liquor nuances on the saline finish. This is next level Sauvignon Blanc that will appeal to novices and connoisseurs alike.

BORDEAUX, G DE GUIRAUD, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2016

Made organically and stirred on texture-gifting lees, this Bordeaux Blanc blend stands out from much of the competition because it's partially aged in barrels that the year before created 1er cru Sauternes. It's intense, rich and complex and has notes of tangerine and grapefruit peel, a touch of redcurrant and a long finish.

SANCERRE LA MERCY-DIEU, DOMAINE BAILLY-REVERDY, LOIRE, FRANCE 2019

I must say this is a serious wine, it's slightly austere and extremely elegant from a famed producer. – Rick

He's not wrong, Bailly-Reverdy makes classic, pure, and energetic Sancerre from their vines just outside Sancerre in the Loire's most famous region. I love this wine with seabass and samphire.

SAVENNIÈRES LES GENETS, DAMIEN LAUREAU, LOIRE, FRANCE 2014

Wow. This wine is the nuts. Damien Laureau is the best in Savennières and has crafted an incredible complex and layered wine with great texture, energy and purity.

RULLY AC, DAVID MORET, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2019

This wine is pale golden in colour. The nose is full with a varying bouquet of flavours; elderberry, lemon, white peach and hints of flint. The palate strikes the characteristically Burgundian balance between acidity and richness, with bright fruit, nuts, oatmeal and notes of honey, a rounded palate and a long finish.
