Sparkling & Champagne

Prosecco Asolo Spumante, Italy NV

Vibrant crisp and exceedingly refreshing. An exquisite Prosecco with a fine delicate mousse and light apple notes.

Rick Stein's Champagne Blanc de Blancs, France NV

René & Vanessa Beaudouin have been producing this Champagne for us for the last thirty years from their tiny winery to the east of Reims.

Champagne Louis Roederer Brut Premier, France NV

The little sibling to Cristal, we think their NV Brut is the best available at the moment.

White

Vermentino, Archeres, Pays D'Oc, France 2019

A rich and refreshing wine from Languedoc, ripe peach and apricot aromas on the nose, enjoy paired with seafood or on it's own.

Verdejo, Rick Stein's Spanish White, Rueda, Spain 2019

After several seafood delights whilst filming in Galicia and drinking a number of Castilla y León from white china cups I had to find a really good one for us. I asked Charlie to find something made from the verdejo grape, it's a wine to celebrate my Spanish book and TV series.

Chardonnay, Urmeneta, Central Valley, Chile 2019

This intense Chardonnay shows aromas of peach and pineapple, that blend perfectly with sweet notes of vanilla, great with prawns and chicken dishes.

Sauvignon Blanc, The Crossings, Marlborough, New Zealand 2019

I find many New Zealand sauvignons to be almost oppressively fruit laden. This though is much more subtle and at a recent tasting we liked it best because of its good balance of leafy flavour with a pleasing round finish.

Albariño, Laurent Miquel, Lagrasse, Languedoc, France 2018

Laurent's new albariño project from vineyards high above the village of Lagrasse with a perfect cool climate, very refreshing with grapefruit, peach and a long lime citrus finish.

Chablis, Alain Geoffroy, Burgundy, France 2018

A traditional style of Chablis with a taut line of minerality running through that enhances the fruit and fine vegetal flavours.

Gavi, La Battistina, Piedmont, Italy 2018

A brilliant representation of Piedmont white wine. 100% Cortese grape, just delicious.

Rick Stein's White Burgundy, Mâcon, France 2019

In 2014 I travelled with the family to Beaune to find the perfect wine to commemorate The Seafood Restaurant's fortieth anniversary. This nutty, buttery and complex wine is fleshy and ripe, but with a wonderful citrus freshness and a touch of oak. It's a fresh, thirst-quenching celebration for people who love the world's best chardonnays. – Charlie Stein

Rosé

Grenache & Syrah, Le Tuffeau, Pays D'Oc France 2019

From the sun-drenched vineyards of Pulcheric, a pleasant nose of strawberry and pomegranate with a pale colour.

Garnacha, Borsao, Spain 2018

A crisp, dry, well balanced rose from the northern slopes of the Moncayo mountain range, in the Campo de Borja region of northeast Spain.

Fresh with the aromas of rice berry fruits, and ideal all seafood dishes and pizza,.

Red

Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon, Whistle Blower, Chile 2019

A youthful and mellow red wine from Chile. A classic combination of cabernet sauvignon and merlot full of juicy red and black fruits with a medium body and soft tannins.

Merlot, Laroche, France 2018

Ripe, juicy and very easy to drink with fabulous cherry, plum and blackcurrant fruit.

Garnacha, Rick Stein's Spanish Red, Campo de Borja, Spain 2019

Rick and his son Charlie worked together to select this wine to match with the flavours he encountered on his journey through Spain. A delicious, juicy and ripe Spanish red made from garnacha.

Appassimento, Casa Vinironia, Puglia, Italy 2019

A soft and smooth red from southern Italy. Appassimento is a way of drying out the grapes which adds concentration and silkiness to the finished wine.

Shiraz, Midday Somewhere, Hesketh, Australia 2017

Brilliant aromatic fruit notes balanced perfectly alongside soft vanilla hues from the quality of French oak barriques. A well-structured palate with berry, coffee and liquorice flavours giving a juicy and elegant wine style.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Hahn Family Estate, Monterey, California, USA 2017

Plush and perfumed blackberry and blueberry fruit. The Hahn family make outstanding red wines that are just dangerously drinkable.

Malbec, Trueno Estate, Mendoza, Argentina 2017

Super smooth, super delicious Malbec with soft juicy red fruit and rounded mouthfeel.
